This letter is to inform you that **Centinela Hospital Medical Center** is no longer a participating provider in Anthem Blue Cross' network, **effective January 1, 2009**.

Anthem Blue Cross physicians who admit to Centinela Hospital Medical Center have been notified of this development and will arrange for admission of Anthem Blue Cross and Anthem Blue Cross Life and Health Insurance Company members to alternate facilities. If you receive a bill from Centinela Hospital Medical Center for services rendered prior to January 1, 2009, please do not pay it. Rather, please contact Anthem Blue Cross at the toll free number on your ID card, so that it may be handled appropriately.
